- Aegon UK has appointed Alison Morris as its new chief risk officer. Alison, subject to regulatory approval, will take up her new role on 4 August, replacing acting CRO Colin Black.
- Amati Global Investors has appointed
 Graeme Bencke as a fund manager to
 develop the firm's global equity strategy.
- Amundi has made three senior hires for its sustainability department. Edouard Dubois will now be head of voting, Alice Sireyjol will act as deputy head of ESG development, while Hélène Champollion-Morel joins as head of advocacy for the firm. All three new hires will be based in Paris and have a strong background in sustainable investing.
